**FOOD VENDORS INFORMATION**  
**IMPORTANT**  
**PLEASE READ**

**1. FIRE & ELECTRICAL INFORMATION –**

All booths that are using electricity and need special hook-up will need the following in their booths.

| 1. Minimum of 30 AMPS       | 4. Wire – Number 10 – 3        |
| 2. Main to handle the AMPS  | 5. Limit of 15 AMPS per load   |
| 3. Cable to handle the AMPS | 6. 20 AMPS outlets must be GFI |

NO EXTENSION CORDS ON THE GROUND – Vendor must furnish own equipment such as a 50-ft. or more heavy-duty extension cord, UL Listed Outdoor Use ONLY tables, chairs, plugs, etc.

**NOTE: IF YOU HAVE DEEP FAT FRYERS USING GREASE IN YOUR CONCESSION, YOU MUST HAVE A 40# ABC FIRE EXTINGUISHER.**

A 10#BC rated dry chemical fire extinguisher must be in all food concessions at all times. If an extinguisher is more than one (1) year old, it must be inspected before set-up. If purchased in 2007, you must have the sales receipt showing the date of purchase. A safety committee will be checking all booths that are using electrical hook-ups.
